

## **AP EXAM CHANGES - 2011**

### **Multiple-Choice Section Scoring**

Beginning with the May 2011 AP Exam administration, total scores on the multiple-choice section will be based only on the number of questions answered correctly. Points will no longer be deducted for incorrect answers and, as always, no points will be awarded for unanswered questions.

### **AP Calculus AB/Calculus BC**

Beginning with the 2011 AP Calculus AB and Calculus BC Exams, the format of the free-response sections will be modified so that Part A (graphing calculator required) consists of two problems to be completed in 30 minutes, and Part B (no calculator allowed) consists of four problems to be completed in 60 minutes. During the timed portion for Part B, students are permitted to continue to work on problems in Part A, but they are not permitted to use a calculator during this time. There is no change in the format of the multiple-choice sections.
